

RESOLUTION NO. 11834

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SCOTTSDALE, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, APPROVING THE DISTRIBUTION OF INTEREST INCOME FROM THE SCOTTSDALE COMMUNITY ENDOWMENT FUND AND THE HERBERT R. DRINKWATER YOUTH SERVICES FUND AND AUTHORIZING THE ALLOCATION OF FUNDS TO RECOMMENDED ACTIVITIES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020/21.

WHEREAS, the Scottsdale Community Endowment Fund and the Herbert R. Drinkwater Youth Services Fund (Endowment Funds) are managed and administered by the Arizona Community Foundation to generate interest income to support various public programs and activities;

WHEREAS, the Human Services Commission has been authorized and designated by the City Council to make recommendations to the Council concerning distributions from the Endowment Funds;

WHEREAS, the Human Services Commission conducted a public process to solicit proposals and heard presentations by agencies seeking Endowment Funds for human services programs and activities for Scottsdale residents; and


WHEREAS, based upon the proposals and presentations, the Human Services Commission recommended that Endowment Funds allocations be made to the McDowell Sonoran Conservancy for their Sonoran Discovery Academy – Expedition Days in the amount of \$2,000;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Scottsdale, Arizona, as follows:


Section 1. The City Council accepts the Human Services Commission recommendation and approves the distribution of interest income from the Scottsdale Community Endowment Fund and the Herbert R. Drinkwater Youth Services Fund for a total amount of \$2,000 to the McDowell Sonoran Conservancy for their Sonoran Discovery Academy – Expedition Days.


